For Primary School aged boys and girls (from 5-12 years)



The next instalment of our Vacation Care program is coming up in the school holidays. Children from the wider community are also warmly welcome to attend any of the activities.

Bring a friend – the more the merrier! We encourage you to come along, try our program and bring along a friend to share the day with.

Whatever the choice, children can enjoy a range of planned play and leisure experiences, practise social skills and solve problems in a safe and relaxed atmosphere.

There is a range of enriching activities on offer for girls and boys.

Families must pre-book the days they would like their child to attend Vacation Care. Your child can attend as few or as many days as needed and days can be selected to suit your schedule and commitments. Children can attend for a full day or just half a day.

Bookings

A Registration Form (including medical details) is required for every child who attends Vacation Care. If you have not already completed the Registration Form, download a copy from the website.

Vacation Care fees are as follows:

- > Half day \$40
- > Full day \$69

Vacation Care is open from 8am to 6pm. Half days can be taken from 8am to 1pm or 1pm to 6pm.

Book early as places are limited

Please note: numbers for each session are capped to:

- > 41 children for activities held at School
- > 31 children for excursions

Once available places have been filled, no further bookings can be accepted. Waiting lists are available. Confirmation of booking notices will not be sent home, however, if any session is booked out and no place is available you will be contacted by the OSHC Coordinator, Sarah Marshall.

In order to finalise staffing, your booking form should be returned to your daughter's class teacher or to the Student Services Desk by Thursday 14 April.

Tuesday 26 April Digital animation


