As a part of their Stage 1 Drama studies, students form an authentic production company. The 2021 ensemble have chosen LimeLight as the name of their company.

In the early 1820s, English inventor Goldsworthy Gurney, improving on the work of earlier scientists, developed a blowpipe that burned hydrogen and oxygen to create an extremely hot flame. When Gurney heated calcium oxide in the flame it produced an intense white light, dubbed **limelight**.

The 10 members of LimeLight intend to demonstrate this effect in their work, shining a light on various themes and issues relevant to their world, allowing intense scrutiny in the hopes of creating meaningful, entertaining performances.
